Relative stay

There are a number of relative beds at the Hospice for family use when the patient is gravely ill, or unable to settle. Please ask a member of staff for details.

Visiting

There is no restriction on visiting, but we do ask that visitors are considerate to other hospice users and we aim to protect patient's privacy during meal times and ask that visitors respect patient's own time when they are tired. As a carer, please also ensure that you allow yourself to have a break and relax.

Telephone

Relatives/friends are not able to phone patients directly but if you call the nurses number the call will be transferred to the patient if they are available and/or pass on any messages for you. There is a iPad available for video calling family, please ask staff members for details.

Food

We ask that visitors do not bring perishable foods and produce into the Hospice as we cannot guarantee their storage. There is an on-site café for carers and relatives to use in Llandudno. Please be reassured that all patient's meals are provided free of charge during their time at St David's Hospice.

Smoking

The Hospice has a strict no smoking policy and we kindly ask that patients, families and staff observe this.
