Community Fundraising

“ Over the past few years I have organised a few events to help raise funds towards St David's Hospice to help them continue the amazing work they do. Having seen first hand in 2021 when they cared for my brother Stuart who sadly passed away at the hospice at the age of 47, the care he received was first class and the staff also ensured we were looked after as well.

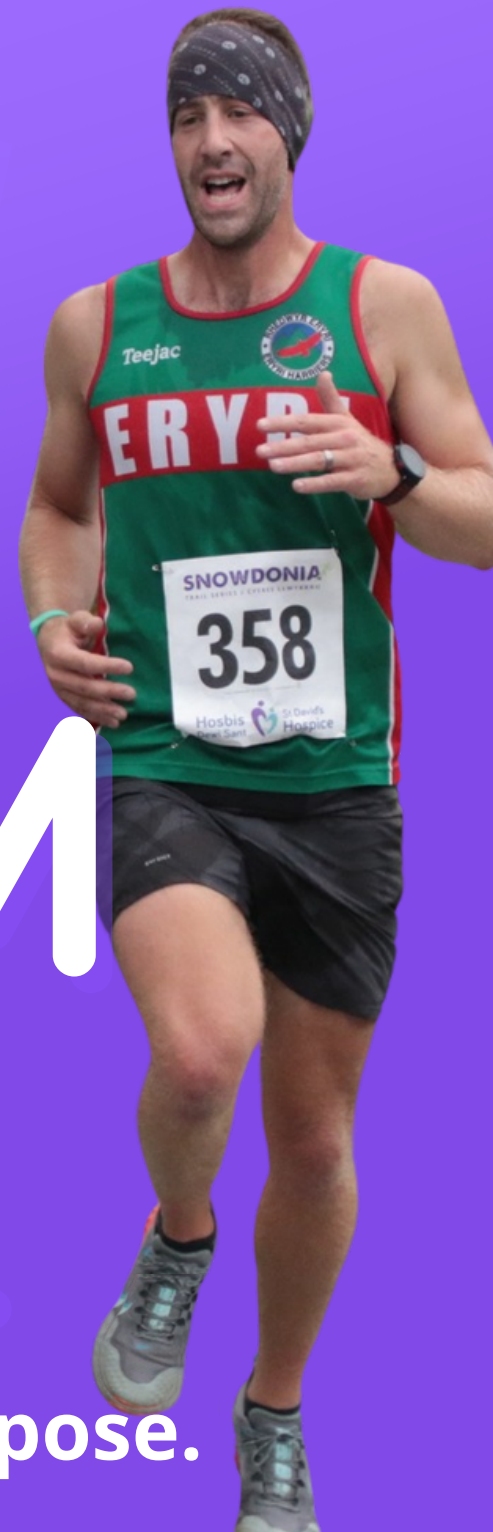
I decided that I had to give something back, so I organised a few events however the popular ones are the one off coffee mornings, held every few months in my local church hall on a Saturday morning for 1.5hrs and raising about £400. I keep it simple, Raffle, Tombola, Craft table, home made cakes and a paned (tea/coffee). I average about 70-100 people through the door and they support each one I arrange.

Keeping the prices low on the stalls helps as people spend more and thus we raise more for the hospice. Clear advertising with a simple poster, banner and social media post on local pages really helps and rope in a few friends to help look after the stalls.”

FUNDRAISING TIPS



- Plan it! It may sound obvious but whether you are going big or keeping it small you still need to know- Where? When? Who? How?
- Use our official 'in aid of logo' this makes it clear that you are fundraising in aid of the Hospice.
- Set a fundraising target so people know how much you are hoping to raise.
- Make it personal- why have you decided to fundraise? Why is the Hospice important to you? Be passionate!
- Reach out to local businesses - they may be able to support you- host a quiz, donate a prize or even match funding
- Keep reminding people what you're doing by sharing your fundraising page
- Take loads of photos of your fundraiser to share afterwards
- If your event was a hit why not make it a regular thing. You can always bring in new elements to keep it fresh
- Thank supporters immediately after the event





GO ONLINE

SET UP FUNDRAISING PAGE

Setting up your online fundraising page is an effective and simple way for your supporters to donate money and keep up to date with your fundraising journey. Enthuse is our preferred platform, and all donations will come directly to St David's Hospice.

SOCIAL SHARING

Don't forget to share your story, photos and updates on your social media and on your fundraising page to encourage people to sponsor you.

EMAIL

Go old school and email your friends to let them know what you're up to. Share your fundraising page with your friends, family and colleagues for their support.

SUPPORT IS KEY

Ask a loved one to be your first sponsor. This will encourage others to donate.



KEEPING IT SAFE AND LEGAL

Whatever your fundraising activity we want you to have fun whilst keeping safe and legal too. We have put some of the basics together for you. But please always reach out if you are not sure. You can also get advice from your local council and the HSE website.

In Aid of:

Although we are here to help we aren't responsible for your event and cannot accept any liability. We recommend you check with your local authority about licenses. We will also provide you with an 'in aid of' Hospice logo to use for promoting your event.

Risk assessment

This is a careful evaluation of what could potentially cause harm to people. We advise you complete a risk assessment early on in your planning.

Insurance

If your event is open to the public you may need to consider arranging public liability insurance, which will protect you against claims for injury or property damage.

Food, alcohol and entertainment:

You may need a license if you are planning to sell alcohol or if there will be music or entertainment. It is important to consider The Food Standards Agency regarding food hygiene

Raffles:

Raffles are a popular way to raise funds, but they are a form of gambling and must follow Gambling Commission rules. Tickets can be sold during an event, but the draw must take place the same day

Collecting money:

You need a license issued by the local authority if you wish to collect funds on the street, a public place or door to door. If you want to collect on private property i.e a supermarket you should ask for permission from the owner.

Children:

Fundraising is a great activity for children and they should be allowed to join in. However they should have permission from a parent or guardian to take part and always be properly supervised throughout.

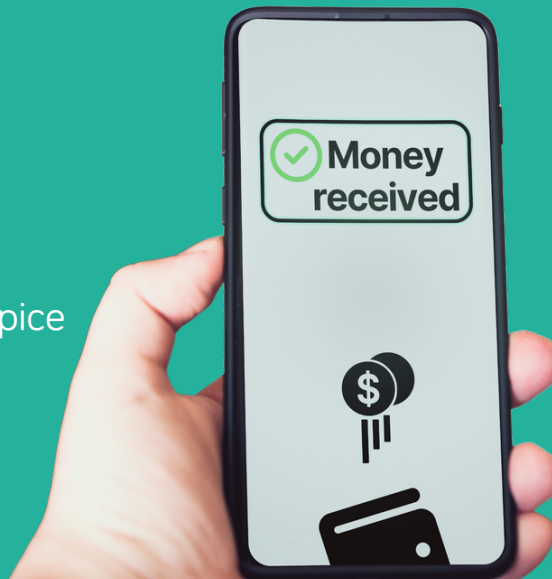
